MEETING MINUTES

1. Welcome

Andrea Jacobson, DHS/DLTC staff to the committee, welcomed both members of the committee and members of the public. All committee members, public attendees and DHS staff introduced themselves.

2. Public Testimony

No public testimony was received.

3. Operational

The committee reviewed minutes from the meeting held on April 29, 2016. Shannon made a motion to approve the meeting minutes; Roger seconded the motion; all approved and the motion carried.

4. Treatment Reviews

No new therapy reviews were requested for this quarter.

5. Treatment Updates

• **Collaborative Proactive Solutions (Initial Review)**

- Tia provided a review on Collaborative Proactive Solutions (CPS), which was requested by the Department to be reviewed.
- No research was identified for targeting this treatment with the autism population. Current research focuses on Oppositional Defiant Disorder populations for targeted age of 7-14 years old. This study indicated improved behavior compared to the control group.
- Tia made a motion to identify this treatment at a level 3 rating for ODD populations age 4-14 years and level 5 rating, untested, for ASD populations. Roger seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

• **Auditory Verbal Therapy (Re-review)**

- Overview of therapy was provided (Lana Collet-Klingenberg presented).
- Motion made by Lana to identify this treatment with a level 4 rating (experimental, insufficient evidence). Seconded by Roger. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Brain Beats (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Tia Schultz presented).
 - No new research was available for this review.
 - Shannon motioned to identify this treatment with a level 5 rating (experimental, untested). Tia seconded the motion; motion approved unanimously.

- **DIR/Floortime (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Shannon Stuart presented).
 - Motion made by Shannon to identify treatment with a level 4 rating (experimental, insufficient evidence). Seconded by Lana. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Early Start Denver Model (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Lana Collet-Klingenberg presented).
 - Motion made by Lana to identify treatment with a level 2 rating (remain at same level – established, moderate evidence). Motion was seconded by Roger. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Roger Bass presented).
 - Motion made by Roger to identify treatment with a level 5 rating (experimental, risk potential for harm). Motion was seconded by Lana. Motion passed unanimously.
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- **Learning Rx (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Shannon Stuart presented).
 - Motion made by Shannon to identify treatment with a level 4 rating. Motion was seconded by Roger. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Me Moves (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Tia Schultz presented).
 - Motion made by Tia to identify treatment with a level 5 rating, as there have been no published studies on the package (experimental, untested). Motion was seconded by Roger. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Multi-Systemic Therapy (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Amy Van Hecke presented).
 - During re-review, determined that there were no identified studies with ASD students, and therefore need to re-evaluate the determination.
 - Motion made by Roger to identify treatment with a level 4 rating (experimental, insufficient evidence) for ASD populations and level 2 rating (established or moderate evidence) for Emotional Disturbance populations. Motion was seconded by Tia. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Music Therapy (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Amy Van Hecke presented).
 - Motion made by Amy to identify treatment with a level 3 rating. Motion was seconded by Tia. Motion passed unanimously.

- **National Association of Child Development Model (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Lana Collet-Klingenberg presented).
 - Motion made by Lana to identify treatment with a level 5 rating (experimental, untested). Motion was seconded by Roger. Motion passed unanimously.
- **Relationship Development Intervention (Re-review)**
 - Overview of therapy was provided (Roger Bass presented).
 - Motion made by Roger to identify treatment with a level 4 rating (experimental, insufficient evidence). Motion was seconded by Lana. Motion passed unanimously.

 - Motion made by Roger to identify treatment with a level 4 rating (experimental, insufficient evidence). Motion was seconded by Lana. Motion passed unanimously.
